## COMPUTER USE AGREEMENT (Years R-2)

(a copy of this agreement is available on our website under the reporting and policies tab)

Access to computers and the Internet is provided for the purposes of educational research and learning. It supports the school's teaching and learning program and is intended to strengthen the quality of student learning. The purpose of this policy is to provide rules for appropriate use of these facilities. Students and parents are asked to carefully read the following agreement.

### Student Computer Use Agreement

I understand that the computers and Internet from Vale Park Primary School are for learning and I agree to the following:

- I will only use websites that my teacher shows me.
- If I see something that makes me uncomfortable I will tell my teacher, the ICT Technician, the Library staff or someone in the Front Office.
- I will only use the computer for playing games if my teacher gives me permission.
- I will write polite emails, polite text messages and engage in social networking sites using netiquette (internet manners).
- I will not download illegal or offensive software, games, music, graphics, videos or text. Copying information is unacceptable.
- I will not install any software, games or multimedia on school computers without the permission of the ICT Technician.
- I will use my USB only for storing my schoolwork, not storing or downloading games or music.
- I will not share my personal information (name, address or telephone number)
- I will not damage the computers (unplugging wires, mice or keyboards, altering software settings).
- I will look after equipment in all computer areas and will not take any equipment without a teacher's permission.
- If I see anyone damaging the computers or taking equipment I will tell my teacher, the ICT Technician, the Library staff or someone in the Front Office.
- I will abide by log-in procedures to access the computer network.
- I will not use anyone else's log-in name or password to use the computer or internet.
- I won't tell other people my log in or password.
- I will not eat or drink while using a computer in the school

If I don't follow any of the terms of this agreement, I will not be able to use the school computers for a period of time. The Principal or their delegate will decide how long I can't use the computers. The Principal or their delegate can decide if there are further consequences for not following the rules. I am aware that each case will be considered individually.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THESE RULES SHOULD ALSO APPLY TO YOUR HOME COMPUTER.

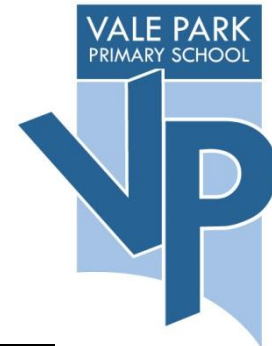
