Food vendors went well as they strived to move their product. Many business' even teaming together to create new items in a mad dash to sell all of their stock, and to maximise profits.



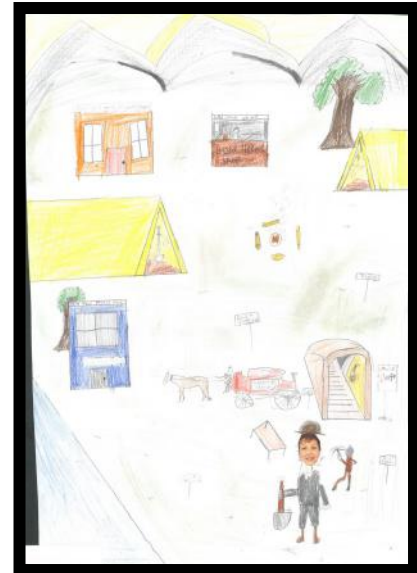
Each business donated their profit to charities including; the RSPCA, the Carly Ryan foundation, Beyond Blue and the World Wildlife Fund.

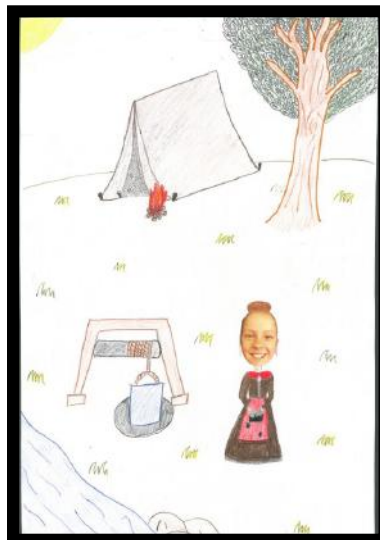
1800s Self Portraits
